

ALL-MAIL BALLOT POST-ELECTION REPORT

Casa Grande Union High School District No. 82 of Pinal County, Arizona
November 7, 2023

A.R.S. Section 16-409 requires that a report be filed with the President of the Arizona Senate and the Speaker of the Arizona House of Representatives for **all school elections conducted via all-mail ballot**.

The deadline for the report is January 1st of each year immediately following an all-mail ballot election.

The report shall include the following:

1. Changes in voter turnout.

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2. Relative costs of mail ballot elections compared to traditional elections.

All-mail - 2023 Draft estimate \$4 per voter In-person - 2023 Draft estimate \$5.75 per voter
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3. Suggestions for improvements or refinements in the mail ballot program.

Additional voter outreach from jurisdictions.
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4. Frequency and severity of mail ballot irregularities.

Nothing reported.

5. Voter satisfaction with the election process.
